# RMHC NEW ZEALAND FAMILY APPEAL

This year we are excited to be holding the RMHC New Zealand Family Appeal across the week of May 7th-13th. The Street Collection is on: Friday 11th May.

Last year, McDonald's Crew made up our biggest team of collectors and raised an incredible \$74,000 of the overall total of \$200,000.

- 3. Community Fundraising

Many of you will have already received your packs in preparation for the week. If you are doing the Street Collection there will be buckets, bibs, stickers, posters, banking bags and an information guide.

# **INVOLVING YOUR COMMUNITY**

An excellent and easy way to raise funds during the Family Appeal is by involving your local community.

Last year, the most successful teams arranged for additional support including:

- Recruiting additional volunteers: The more collectors you have in your group, the easier it will be
  to raise funds! Simply ask for helping hands from friends, local businesses, schools and community
  groups.
- Approaching local schools to hold a Mufti Day: RMHC New Zealand has posters and packs for schools.
- **Spread the word:** Ask your local radio station and newspapers for an announcement, drop flyers, put up posters, or simply post on social media. RMHC New Zealand has adverts available.

# **BANKING PROCESSES**

It is important to RMHC New Zealand that we **acknowledge and thank the appropriate people** for their hard work and efforts in raising funds. We also need to know exactly where the funds have come from and through what type of fundraising. This can be hard to do with **168 restaurants** making regular deposits, and not all restaurants providing adequate information.

Therefore, here is a reminder of the banking processes to follow to ensure your team's efforts are correctly coded and acknowledged.

We have created a simple one-pager outlining the RMHC New Zealand banking processes which has been emailed to all Franchisees. It is also available on metimemedia.

## **Key points:**

- Always provide the **correct reference** and your **store ID** for both cash and electronic transfers.
- Always use your **RMHC New Zealand restaurant-specific Westpac deposit book** when depositing cash.

• Don't combine donations that come from different sources (e.g. collection box and community fundraising).

## **Deposited Monthly**

- Collection Boxes
- Payroll Giving

## Deposited at the close of the event or activity

- · Raffles.
- Community fundraising (e.g. market days, garage sales).
- National campaigns (e.g. Family Appeal, Season of Giving).



Always use your restaurant-specific deposit book (Example: Queenstown Frankton)

Remember to send an email to **rmhcaccounts@rmhc.org.nz** whenever you deposit money from a fundraiser you have held so that we know it is different from collection box money.

## **Invoiced every six months**

Register/Kiosk donations.
